LETTER FROM THE KP PRESIDENTS

We hope that everyone is doing ok during this difficult situation. The coronavirus is having a major impact on our community, our country, and the rest of the world. Our thoughts are with each and every one of our Kingspoint households as we all take things a day at a time.

The positive news is that we live in a truly wonderful neighborhood where everyone is supportive and caring. Although we cannot get together to socialize, and everyone should be practicing social distancing, we hope that folks are able to get out for walks and simply get the chance to say hello to each other (even if from a distance). For those in need, please know that the neighborhood is there to support you. Friends and neighbors are just a call away.

We do not know how long the virus impact will be on our community. As we previously announced, the Clubhouse is closed until further notice. Right now, we are planning on 2020 events such as the Memorial Day picnic (May 25th), the annual Concert on the Green (June 13th), July 4th parade, and Labor Day picnic (September 7th). We had also identified Saturday, April 18th, as the spring clubhouse cleanup date. We will make a decision as that date approaches as to whether we will need to reschedule or not. If virus impacts continue into late spring, we will work with the pool company on what steps to take regarding this summer's pool status.





Likewise, the Drug Take Back program (April 25) and household chemical recycling (April 11) were also cancelled by the police and VPPSA. James City County has closed areas where people can congregate, and potentially spread the virus, such as the libraries, rec centers, ball fields and playgrounds. Parks with walking and bike trails remain open.
