LETTER FROM THE KP PRESIDENTS

Monday evenings in June and July were exciting times when we had swimmers and families cheering for the win. With the swim season wrapping up, we look forward to seeing many families catching up and relaxing at the pool.

Please note the following announcements regarding the pool, club-house rentals, and social activities.

Pool Safety: Given the national lifeguard shortage our country is experiencing, the KP Club has changed our minimum age requirement for unattended children at the pool. Children 12 and under must be supervised by parents and guardians over 18. (Please note that this is a change from previous years.) Also, as in past years, the baby pool does not have lifeguard supervision; therefore, all children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian in the baby pool. Finally, please note that the first 45 minutes of each hour will be guarded, followed by the last 15 minutes of each hour being guard-free—adults only/swim at your own risk. Please plan pool arrival time accordingly.

Resident Memberships: Please check to make sure your household is up-to-date on your membership.

- 1. All members must be in good standing to use the pool.
- 2. Quarterly paying members should have no more than \$150 left on their balance.
- 3. Third quarter dues were due on July 1, 2022.
- 4. The next quarterly payment of \$150 is due by October 1, 2022.

- 6. Out-of-town house-guests are free
- 7. Local grandchildren are free.
- 8. All other local guests are \$5 per person (Note: Kingspoint residents that are not club members cannot be guests).
- 9. Please use the "pay box" at the lifeguard stand.

Non-Resident Memberships: Know anyone in Williamsburg interested in joining the Kingspoint Club memberships for non-residents are available and they include summer access to the pool. Rates HAVE NOT changed in 2022. Rates are \$285 for a single person or \$360 for a family. The pool opens on Memorial Day weekend. Non-Resident Club memberships are a great way to increase revenue for the KP Club, so let local friends and families know that we are accepting applications.

The Clubhouse: The Clubhouse: The KP Clubhouse is open for business and fun! Our Clubhouse can be rented by both members and non-members. (All stockholder members get one free 1/2 day rental each year AND all KP Club members get reduced rental rates.) Spread the word that our wonderful facility is available for rent and has the best rates in town. The clubhouse has wonderful views and great amenities.

 - (a) Electronic invoices were emailed from our KP Club QuickBooks account (received from Kingspoint Club, Inc., or quickbooks@notification.intuit.com).
 - (b) Open the Kingspoint Club Electronic Invoice Email and select Review and pay.

- (c) Select the Edit amount icon to edit the Payment Amount.
- (d) Enter the partial amount.
- (e) Complete the rest of the fields and select Pay.
- (f) The Treasurer will be emailing the final round of electronic invoices on September 30, 2022.
- (g) Email KPPresidents@gmail.com or the Treasurer, KPWilliamsburg@gmail.com, if you have questions about the Quickbooks process or you would like to receive a paper invoice in the 2022 season.

Neighborhood Watch

Please be careful to lock your car whether at home, or out and about, and keep any valuables, including loose change, out of sight. There are reports of thefts from cars every week now, and sometimes several times a week. There have been thefts from cars left in the lot at Freedom Park. Several neighborhoods have been hit in recent weeks. Sometimes this is occuring at night, but the Freedom Park thefts (I know of at least 3 separate instances) all occurred during the day with people coming and going. If a thief sees a desirable object in your car, they may break in. Many of the thefts have been from unlocked cars when thieves just opened the door and checked all of the usual places for things to steal. County residents report having credit cards, guns, purses, cash, and electronics stolen.

So far, there haven't been any recent incidents in Kingspoint. I trust it will stay that way. But please don't let yourself become a victim of a random theft as you go about your routine.

Please help us discourage anyone from going door to door in the neighborhood by declining to do business with them and by informing them of our "No Solicitor's" policy.
